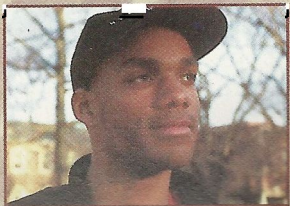


**Eric Clark** (LC'98), who kept a journal as a senior member of the Scarlet Knights men's basketball team for our Spring 1998 issue, married shortly after graduation and has played professionally in Spain, Colombia, and Portugal. In Portugal this past season, he averaged 16 points a game, led the league in blocked shots, and twice battled his former Rutgers teammate, Rob Hodgson (RC'98), who plays for a league rival. Two seasons ago Clark helped the Bogota Piratas win a championship in front of 13,000 fans, the largest crowd to watch a basketball game in Colombia's history.
